1. A. We will provide one-time college scholarships to Timberview High School graduating Senior band students who qualify. These scholarships will be awarded directly to the approved recipients, based on our qualification criteria. These recipients must be excellent students, proven leaders, and active participants in the Timberview High School music program.
 - B. The scholarships are designed to assist Timberview High School music students offset the costs of higher education. The amount of each scholarship and the number of scholarships awarded each year will depend on the number of qualified applicants and the funds available to the Timberview Band Parents organization.

Graduating students from Timberview High School who actively participate in the band program.
 4. A. Selection Criteria
 - ❖ Active participant in Timberview High School Band Program
 - ❖ Minimum GPA 3.2 (attach transcript)
 - ❖ 3 Letters of recommendation – at least one to be from a teacher

- ❖ Band Director's recommendation
- ❖ Matriculating to an accredited college or university
- ❖ Must have participated in the Band program for at least 3 years

B. & C. Scholarships will be awarded based on Merit. All qualified applicants will be ranked on the above criteria, and awards are given based on rank and scholarship funds available.

D. Scholarships are not renewable
